- All abstracts must be in English language and typed in Times New Roman, 12 font.
- Submit the abstracts as per the format, which includes Title of the abstract, Authors and co-authors and their affiliations (Underline the presenting author's name and indicate the author affiliation with superscript numbers).
- Abstracts should be structured including background, objective, methodology, results, and conclusion along with 3-5 keywords.
- Word limit for the abstract is 250 words.
- The acceptance for oral/poster presentations will be sent through mail.
- **Poster dimension should be 4 feet in height and 3 feet in width.**
- **Oral presenters should have up to maximum of 15 slides and will be given 5+2 min for presentation followed by discussion.**
