About the Seminar:

Traditional Medicines (TM) are practiced in an ancient manner mostly indigenous to a country or region. This system has evolved by several indigenous peoples on the basis of religious beliefs and social edifies for the maintenance of their own healthcare system through exploring the natural resources. Traditional Medicine includes Ayurveda, Unani Sidhha, and Homeopathy (AYUSH) from Indian systems of medicine (ISM), traditional Chinese medicine (TCM) from China and several other systems derived from different cultural perspectives. It is quite popular among people due to their health benefits, traditional beliefs, economical advantage, easily available and religious and social consciousness. TM systems lack proper scientific validated data and improper regulatory basis which are the major challenges for the development and promotion. Scientific validation and quality control of TMs are a critical and essential for assuring the therapeutic efficacy, safety and to rationalize their use in the healthcare. Thus TM requires the confluence of modern techniques and integrated approaches for the validation of botanicals.

The Ethnopharmacology based study deals with the exchange of traditional information and understandings about the Ayurveda and their biological as well as pharmacological activities based on the principles established worldwide. Many valuable drugs (e.g., aspirin, atropine, curcumin, catechin, ephedrine, tubocurarine, digoxin, reserpine, taxol etc.) have been explored from TMs.

This multi-disciplinary conference will provide an ideal platform for interaction, debate, fusion and dissemination of ideas between emerging young researchers, students and professionals.
