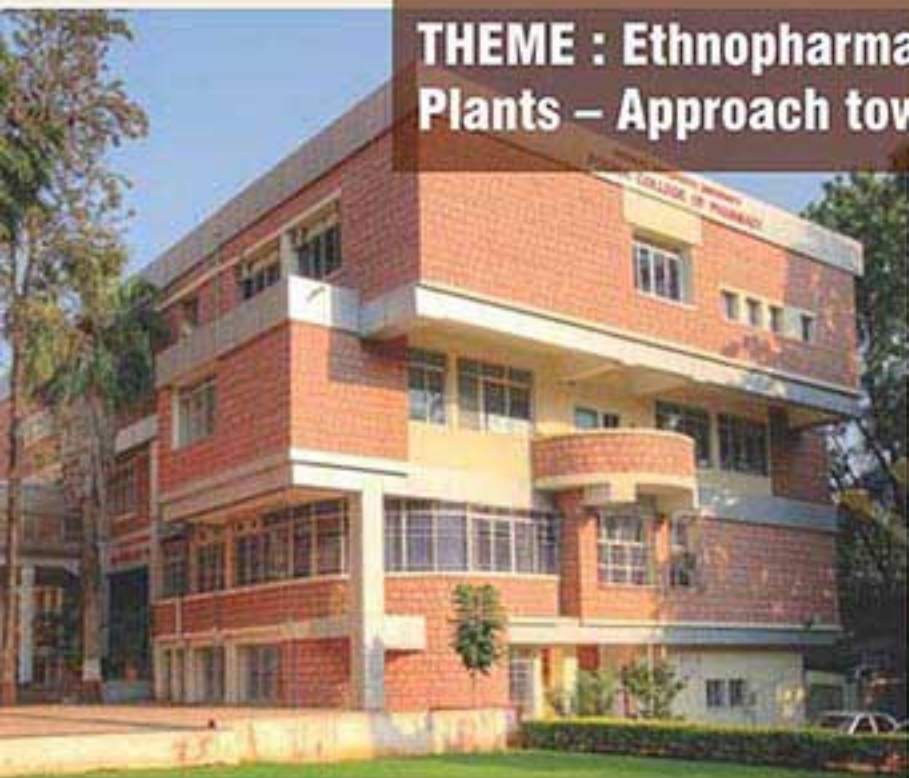

Registration Policy

IN AND AROUND PUNE



Sinhgadh Fort

If you love adventure then this fort is the best place to visit. The fort is located on the Bhuleshwar range of Sahyadri hills, which makes it a perfect spot for trekking. The place will take you back to the times when during the Maratha Empire, the fort was an active military outpost. Shaniwarwada

As an act of charity, the palace existed and the Sultan who built it wanted to help the poor in the region.

Shreemath Dagdusheth Halwai Temple

A famous Ganesha temple in Pune is Shreemath Dagdusheth Halwai Temple which is a major attraction in Maharashtra. The temple is visited by thousands of pilgrims every year. The annual ten-day celebrations named Ganeshotsav is the main festival conducted at the temple when celebrities and ministers arrive to pay tribute to the Lord. Osho Ashram

Osho Ashram is one of the famous tourist places in Pune located in the Koregaon Park. The founder of the ashram was Rajneesh Chandra Mohan Jain who is famous among the people as Osho Rajneesh. The ashram has got another title as Osho Commune International of Pune and it is spread across 32 acres of land.

Lal Mahal

Lal Mahal has another name as Red Palace. It is a beautiful monument established in 1630 AD by Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj's father Shahaji Bhosale for his wife and son. Shivaji Maharaj lived here for a long time until the time he captured his first fort.



Raja Dinkar Kelkar Museum

A minuscule lane, one among the many in the bustling, momentous city of Pune in Maharashtra, is home to Raja Dinkar Kelkar Museum, a rare anthology of Indian artifacts that echo myriad tales of a nostalgic legacy within the majestic archways and corridors. It is the one-man collection of Late Dr. D.G. Kelkar (1896 -1990). The impressive Museum collection of 22,000 priceless artifacts recalls the historic Indian culture and traditions, which gently lead to more and more treasures. Every corner of the Museum bears testimony to an astounding individual passion for art collection. Everyone must visit the museum to experience the wonder.



How to Reach?

Pune, also called 'Poona', is situated in the state of Maharashtra, India. It is also known as the 'Queen of the Deccan' and attained its high importance when it became the capital of Bhonsle Marathas in the 17th century. Being the second largest city of Maharashtra, Pune is known for its rich Maratha culture and well-established manufacturing. Dating back to its history, the city was ruled by Rashtrakutas and very popular, Shri Shivaji Maharaj was the one who built his empire from Pune.

It is the cultural capital of India, Pune is often described as the "Oxford of the East" due to the presence of several prestigious educational institutions and research centers. The city has become a major education hub in the country.

Pune is well-connected with the public transport including Pune Suburban Railway, autos, rickshaws and buses. Also, the facility of Ola and Uber is available throughout the city.

By Road: Pune is well-connected to other cities by Indian and state highways. National Highway 48 connects it to Mumbai and Bangalore, National Highway 65 connects it to Hyderabad and National Highway 60 connects it to Nashik. State Highway 27 connect Pune to Ahmednagar.

The Mumbai Pune Expressway is India's first six-lane high-speed expressway, and it was built in 2002. Only four wheeled vehicles are allowed on it. This expressway has reduced travel time between Pune and Mumbai to a little over two hours. A ring road is planned around the city.

By Rail: The nearest railway station (about 3 km), is connected to Mumbai, Goa, Delhi, Chennai, Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam, Ahmedabad.

By Air: The nearest airport is Pune International Airport at Pune (about 17 km, 40 minutes' drive by road), has daily domestic flights connecting Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, Hyderabad, Bengaluru. There are international flights connecting Dubai, Abu Dhabi, Sharjah, and Frankfurt.
