## ARTICLE TYPES, AUTHOR GUIDELINES & WHY PUBLISH IN SESB

### Types of Articles

- Original Research Articles
- Review Articles (narrative, systematic, or scoping reviews)
  - Perspectives and Commentaries
  - Policy, Regulatory, and Governance Analyses
- Methodological and Articles relevant to systems ethnopharmacology

### Author Guidelines – Key Points

- Structured abstracts  
(Rationale/Purpose, Aims/Scope, Methods, Results, Conclusion)
- Clear scientific rationale and methodological transparency
- Ethical handling of traditional knowledge and data sources
- Reference formatting consistent with ethnopharmacology standards
  - Rigorous, fair, and constructive peer-review process
